Dear AFSCME Staff Member,

The University is upgrading the online hiring system that is used to collect applications for open positions. With this upgrade in partnership with AFSCME local leadership, University Human Resources will be updating the method by which employees can request a contract transfer to contract covered positions. No longer will employees need to submit a paper form in addition to their online application.

Effective with the rollout of the new system on Tuesday, September 9, 2014, employees wishing to exercise their contract transfer rights will need to complete the questions on the application when requesting a contract transfer for the position. Failure to request contract transfer on the application by the contract transfer deadline will negate your ability to use this option. You must appropriately select your request or deselect your previous request for contract transfer on each application. You are encouraged to review your entire application each time you apply before submitting.

The new system will not have historical applications you previously submitted before September 9, 2014. Please allow for additional time when applying the first time in the new system as you will have to create a new account and create a new application. Once you have created an application, you will have the option to modify it each time you wish to apply or use contract transfer.
